**Call for Student Mobility on the framework of Blended Intensive
Programme/BIP
Academic years 2025-2026 (call 2024)**

Title: Emergency Medicine in a changing world

Undergraduate Students of the University of Crete (1st cycle of studies) are invited to apply for blended intensive program mobility under the Erasmus+ framework.

In total: 8 eligible positions for students of the Medical School, of the University of Crete for the Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Program (BIP), which is organized during the spring semester of the academic year 2025–2026 by the Medical University of Sofia, Bulgaria (1st cycle of studies).

Topic: The Blended Intensive Program (BIP) “Emergency Medicine in a Changing World” is designed for undergraduate students interested in the evolving challenges of emergency healthcare in a rapidly changing global context. The program addresses how demographic shifts, technological innovation, climate change, global health threats, and societal transformations are reshaping emergency medicine and acute care systems worldwide.

The interdisciplinary BIP combines online learning activities with a short-term physical mobility, bringing together students from different European higher education institutions. Participants will gain insight into contemporary emergency medicine practices while developing a broader understanding of healthcare systems and cross-border cooperation.



Key topics include:

- Emergency care in the context of climate change, disasters, and extreme events
- Digital technologies and innovation in emergency medicine (telemedicine, AI-supported diagnostics, decision support systems)
- Preparedness and response to pandemics and global health emergencies
- Emergency medicine in aging and diverse populations
- Ethical, legal, and organizational challenges in emergency healthcare

By the end of the program, participants will have developed a foundational understanding of emergency medicine in a changing world, enhances their clinical reasoning and teamwork skills, and strengthened their intercultural competence. The BIP prepares students to adapt to future challenges in emergency healthcare while promoting resilience, innovation and collaboration across European health systems.

Requirements/ Academic background/ Level of studies

1. Students of the 1st cycle of studies
2. Very good knowledge of the English language (B1 language certificate)
3. Curriculum Vitae
4. Letter of Interest (Motivation Letter)

Scoring criteria:

- Motivation letter: 3 points
- CV: 3 points

In case there is a tie after the evaluation of the above criteria, the student who has the highest score in the criterion of successful completion of courses or attendance of seminars, will be given priority. If there is still a tie, each of the remaining criteria will be examined sequentially in the hierarchical order that they are reflected above. If all criteria are exhausted, the Selection Committee conducts a draw.

PERSONAL DATA
