• **Certification:** Earn **3 ECTS credits** for successfully completing the program.

Eligibility and Selection Criteria- (Required)

- ✓ Undergraduate Student (third year of studies)
- ✓ Level of English (Very Good) (C1-3 points)
- ✓ Letter of Motivation (max 500 words- up to 10 points)
- ✓ Curriculum Vitae (in English)

Optional

- ✓ Level of English (Excellent)(C2-3 points)
- ✓ Courses/Seminars relevant to sustainable development and resilience (2 points for each course)

<u>Interview</u>

Selected candidates may be invited to a short interview by the evaluation committee.

Five people will be selected who meet the necessary qualifications and have the highest number of points. Based on the number of applications, priority will be given to students who have not participated in previous INGENIUM Junior Schools.

Travel and accommodation expenses for students are covered by the INGENIUM - European University program.
